Based within our space at the Carmarthenshire Living Well centre at Parc Sant Dewi but with regular travel throughout Carmarthenshire and beyond, this role will have the opportunity to offer direct support to our children and families as well as develop, support and manage volunteers in delivering support in the lead up to and following a bereavement.

This role is great for those passionate about having the opportunity to support our families directly, whilst also being involved in broader development work to enable strong collaborations and partnerships which empower people to achieve better outcomes.

The post is offered on a full-time basis, though flexible working patterns and some reduced hours may be considered.
